GREENWAY GIANTS – COACH’S DUTIES

- At a minimum, a coach must have a Level O coaching certificate. If they do not have one, it should be discussed with the relevant age coordinator who will arrange for a club-sponsored course to be conducted early in the season. The club encourages coaches to go on to do further levels of their coaching certificates.
- The coach must have a good understanding of the rules of baseball. The club encourages our coaches to attend the umpires training sessions for assistance
- The coach’s conduct at all games, training sessions and club related functions will reflect that of the club’s ‘code of conduct’
- The coach will attend all coaches meetings when required and incorporate the recommended methods into team training as appropriate.
- The coach’s attire will always reflect that of their position within the club and that of their team
- It is the coach’s responsibility to instruct the players in all facets of the game. If specialized assistance is required, they are to refer immediately to the coaching or age coordinator.
- The coach will train the team for a minimum of 1 hour a week
- The coach must apply duty of care to each players fitness
 - The coach will, prior to all games, conduct a warm up session lasting a minimum of ½ an hour
 - The coach controls the team during training, the warm-up & the game
 - The coach must abide to any playing rules and/or limitations applied by the association
- The coach will at all times positively encourage all players in their team
- There must be no negative comments allowed about anyone connected with the game from the coach
- The coach will determine the batting line up and will give a copy of that line up to the scorer 15 minutes before the game starts
- The kit is issued to the coach and is their responsibility throughout the season. Any missing or damaged items beyond what is the result of normal wear and tear will be replaced at the team’s expense.
- The coach will collect and return the kit to the equipment officer at the times and place nominated by the club.
